To be eligible, faculty must meet each of the following criteria: (1) hold the rank of assistant professor or above; (2) be tenured or tenure track; (3) teach Biology courses taken by students majoring in Biology/Biological Sciences; and (4) be actively engaged in research. Each selected participant must submit a one-page project summary prepared according to NSF's Grant Proposal Guide that would form the basis for a fully developed proposal for submission to the Foundation's Directorate for Biological Sciences no later than Friday, February 23.
