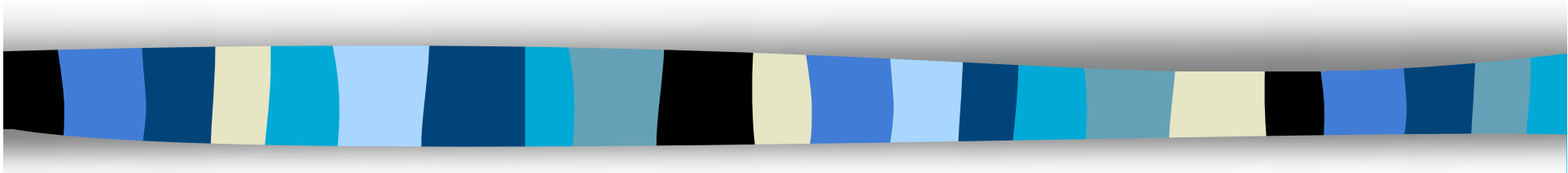

# Timelines (10 Weeks)

---

1. **Start Date:**

# Poster Presentation

---

At the August 2010 Session III you will be expected to participate in a LDI Summer Research Poster Presentation wherein you will describe your research project and includes a discussion of your results and findings along with a Summary of the Benefits derived from the Summer Research Experience.



# Housing Allowance

---

**A Housing Allowance up to \$1,600 will be paid directly to you at the beginning of your Summer Research Experience**

**(You will need to provide documentation to QEM to show that your housing expenses were at least \$1,600)**



# Travel

---

One Round Trip airline ticket from your home to the research site will be provided. (Mr. Hassan will make arrangements and purchase tickets.)

Drivers may receive mileage reimbursement up to the cost of the RT airline ticket.



# Summer Stipend

---

A Stipend of \$10,000 will be paid directly to you in three installments as shown below for your Summer Research Experience

| 1 <sup>st</sup> | one-third -     | May 31, 2010  |
| 2 <sup>nd</sup> | one-third -     | June 18, 2010 |
| 3 <sup>rd</sup> | final payment - | July 23, 2010 |

The second and third installments will be payable upon receipt of satisfactory mid-term and final research reports.

(You need to provide summer contact information to QEM as soon as you have it so your stipend can be mailed to you without delay)

# Some Suggestions for a Successful Summer Research Experience

---



Contact your mentor early. Obtain and read background publications on your topic and by your mentor.



Plan ahead and begin making arrangements for housing as early as possible. Most Centers have an Outreach/Education Coordinator who may be able to assist you.



Make sure your department chair and dean are aware of your pending summer research project.



## Some Suggestions for a Successful Summer Research Experience

---



Remember that the Center and your Mentor have voluntarily agreed to host you. Therefore, please become aware of all Center rules and regulations and carefully follow them at all times.






Make sure you attend all research group meetings of your mentor, as well as Center Seminars.



# Some Suggestions for a Successful Summer Research Experience

---

-  You will be surprised how fast 10 weeks will pass so you should begin work on your project as soon as you arrive.
-  You should begin discussing the details of your proposed project with your mentor which should enable you to get a very good idea of what you will be doing.
-  In the end, the benefits you receive from this experience will largely depend on you and how hard you are willing to work.
